Freedom of Information: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information about Witney Radio MCA map (CR101261BA).

We received this request on 20 January 2022 and it was forwarded by our Broadcast licensing team to process as a freedom of information request. We have considered it under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your request

You asked: 'I have looked on your website for their latest FM MCA map with their new relays and notice the MCA map is only for a single site. Is it possible you could update the MCA map on your website at some point or send me the latest MCA map for Witney Radio?'

Our response

The coverage map for Witney which includes the coverage extensions which have been launched by the service at Chipping Norton, Eynsham and Stonesfield is now available on the Ofcom website, here. You may also note that the relay for Faringdon is not included in the attached map. This is because this relay has not yet been launched by the Licensee. Ofcom will only update and publish a revised version of this map once the relay has been launched.

If you are unhappy with the response you have received in relation to your request for information and/or consider that your request was refused without a reason valid under the law you may ask for an internal review. If you ask us for an internal review of our decision, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom.

The following outcomes are possible:

- the original decision is upheld; or
- the original decision is reversed or modified.

Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for responding to internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review. If you wish to request an internal review, you should contact information.requests@ofcom.org.uk.
