Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information concerning mobile network operator licences issued in 1985, 1993 and 1994. Your request was received on 17 May 2022 and we have considered it under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your request & our response

In brief, you requested the licences issued to Vodafone Ltd ("Vodafone") and Telecom Securicor Cellular Radio Ltd ("Cellnet") in circa 1985, and the subsequent licences issued to Vodafone and Cellnet in December 1993 and March 1994 respectively. You were particularly interested in receiving copies of the condition(s) of those licences.

Please find these attached, labelled as Annex 1 (*Telecom Securicor Cellular Radio Ltd*), Annex 2 (*Vodafone*), the subsequent licences issued to Vodafone (Annex 3) and BT Cellnet (Annex 4).

- the original decision is upheld; or
- the original decision is reversed or modified.

Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review **you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter**. There is no statutory deadline for responding to internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review. If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
