Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your follow-up request for information concerning international letters sent from and to Great Britain, across all carriers. Your request was received on 23 September 2022 and we have considered it under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the "FOI Act").

Your request

- 1.) Number of international letters for distribution in Great Britain from 2018 2021
- 2.) Number of international letters for distribution abroad from 2018 2021

Letters in this context refer to both:

- "letters" up to length 240mm, width 165mm, thickness 5mm and weighing no more than 100g; and
- "Large Letters" means any item larger than a Letter and up to length 353mm, width 250mm, thickness 25mm and weighing no more than 750g

Our response

We do not hold the requested information across all carriers. With the exception of Royal Mail (please refer to our previous FOI response), other operators do not break down data in the same format.

The data that is available can be found in our <u>Annual monitoring updates on the postal market</u> and associated <u>Post monitoring interactive data</u>.

- the original decision is reversed or modified.

Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review **you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter**. There is no statutory deadline for responding to internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review. If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
