Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information concerning EMF compliance data for Thanet. Your request was received on 12 December 2022 and we have considered it under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the "FOI Act") and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (the "EIR").

Your request

In terms of any additional ICNIRP or operator licence condition compliance data held for Thanet. ie. outside of the published audit surveys below. The Thanet area (including Westage, Birchington and Broadstairs/Westwood Cross) does not appear to have been audited by Ofcom. Please could you confirm whether you hold any other relevant data for Thanet?

Our response

We can confirm that we do not currently hold any EMF-related compliance data for mobile network operators in Thanet. However, we are continuing to carry out EMF measurements and compliance checks across the UK and plan to include the Thanet area in the future.

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Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review **you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter**. There is no statutory deadline for responding to internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review.
