### Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request concerning all information Ofcom holds on IX Wireless. Your request was received on 27 June 2023 and we have considered it under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the "FOI Act").

#### Your request

*"please can I respectfully request all information you have on this company  
Licence permission mps donations, comments, finances etc"*

#### Our response

We can confirm that we hold information about this company, however we consider that disclosure of this information is exempt under section 44 of the FOI Act. Section 44 of the FOI Act exempts the disclosure of information which is prohibited by another enactment. In this case, we are prohibited under section 393 of the Communications Act 2003 from disclosing information which relates to a business (in this case, IX Wireless), which we have obtained in exercising our powers, unless we have the consent of that business or one of the statutory gateways for disclosure under section 393(2) is met, neither of which applies here. Section 44 is an absolute exemption and does not require a public interest test.

**Timing**

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review **you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter**. There is no statutory deadline for responding to internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review. If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
