Dear eSafety colleagues,

You likely saw that on Tuesday Ofcom published a [call for evidence](#) focused on the protection of children online. This call for evidence is now open, and we will be accepting written responses until 21 March 2023.

We are seeking evidence from a wide range of stakeholders, to strengthen our understanding of the range of approaches and techniques that platforms can employ to help them meet their future online safety duties in respect of children. The questions we pose differ from those in the call for evidence we published in July, which focused on illegal harms.

Of course we understand that it is holiday-time in Australia at the moment, but as with our last call for evidence, would welcome feedback from eSafety.
