Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information about the comedy output of BBC Wales.

We received this request on 16 April and requested further clarification on 26 April 2024 and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your request

Could you please tell me how many hours of comedy content has BBC Wales made in the last five years TV and Radio for

- 1. Programmes made in Wales for the whole of the BBC.
- 2. Also output made specifically by BBC Wales for the regional BBC variations.
- 3. And out of that content how many hours have
- A Featured Kirk Pritchard Maclean
- B Featured Robin Morgan
- C Been produced by Little Wander

Our response

We do not hold this detail in respect of the BBC's radio output. However, for 2018-2022 inclusive (the last five years for which data have been published), we can provide the following information about the BBC's TV output according to data submitted to us (which does not include information about the on-screen talent in the programmes):

- 1. For the whole of the UK, there were 9 hours of first-run UK originated comedy content aired on the BBC's public service TV channels which qualified as made in Wales under our regional production guidance. None of this was produced by Little Wander.
- 2. Over 2018-2022, there were 37.15 first-run originated comedy hours for BBC One Wales and BBC Two Wales, which qualified as regional programming made in Wales. Of this, 5.83 hours was produced by Little Wander.

In respect of question 3. A and B, we do not hold this information. You may wish to contact the BBC directly for further information relating to your query.

Request an internal review
