Thank you for your request for information about PMSE data wireless cameras 2010-2025MHz.

We received this request on 1 August 2024 and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ("the FOI Act").

## Your request

To inform the BBC response to this consultation please could you supply the number of PMSE assignments for Wireless Cameras in the range 2010-2025MHz for each of the past five years. You will be aware that 10MHz channels centred on 2015 and 2025MHz overlap this range considered in the consultation and that 2010-2025MHz is an EU harmonised band for Wireless Cameras

### Information Requests

#### Request an internal review

If you are unhappy with the response you have received to your request for information, or think that your request was refused without a reason valid under the law, you may ask for an internal review. If you do, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will either uphold the original decision, or reverse or modify it.

If you would like to ask us to carry out an internal review, you should get in touch within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for us to complete our internal review, and the time it takes will depend on the complexity of the request. But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress. #### Taking it further

If you are unhappy with the outcome of our internal review, then you have the right to complain to the Information Commissioner's Office.
