## Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information concerning Uncanny complaints.

We received this request on 3 December 2025 and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (“the FOI Act”).

### Your request

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*“I would like to make an FOI request in relation to both the BBC radio programme/podcast and television programme UNCANNY, specifically:*

- \* UNCANNY Radio/podcast - 5 series running from 23 October 2021 - 18 November 2025*
- \* UNCANNY TV series - 2 seasons running from 13 October 2023 - 21 February 2025*

*I would like to know:*

- \* how many complaints, if any, you have received about the content of the programme,*
- \* if there are any particular episodes that received more complaints than others*
- \* and, if so, what the nature of the complaints were”*

## Information Requests

### Request an internal review

If you are unhappy with the response you have received to your request for information, or think that your request was refused without a reason valid under the law, you may ask for an internal review. If you do, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will either uphold the original decision, or reverse or modify it.

There is no statutory deadline for us to complete our internal review, and the time it takes will depend on the complexity of the request. But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress.
