Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information about 5 masts at Killycoply.

We received this request on 16 January 2025 and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

Your request and our response

This is a formal request for information relating to 5 x Radio masts located 330meters away from our property. The GPS coordinates of the masts are 54.59155053715985, -6.575645632038488 situated on the wood-house road, killycoply, BT71 5HH (Please see attachment 1 for an image of the masts in question) And the GPS coordinates of our property are 54.590285539303494, -6.570871300898238 also situated on the woodhouse road, killycoply, BT71 5HH. (please see attachment 2 for an image of the distance between the masts and our property)

The information I would like relating to these 5 radio masts are as follows

1 – Can you provide readings of exposure to electromagnetic frequencies (EMF) that we may be exposed to being only 330meters away.

We do not hold this information.

2 – Do the masts have any broadcasting ability on the 3g, 4g and 5g bandwidth spectrum?

We can confirm the masts are not phone masts therefore we do not hold this information.

3 – Do the masts have any ability to intercept mobile phone communications? Such as sms messages and voice calls?

We do not hold this information.

4 – Are the masts utilized by any military or law enforcement agencies?

We do not hold this information.
