Please could Ofcom confirm, using the newly provided coordinates: Whether Hutchison 3G UK Limited or MBNL (Mobile Broadband Network Limited) have equipment situated at the Site."

Our response

Having reviewed the data we hold, it is historic and incomplete, and whilst our held records show that MBNL was present, we have since checked with them and they have confirmed that they do not currently operate any equipment at this site. Our records show that Hutchison 3G UK Limited equipment is not present at the site, but you would need to contact them directly for accurate and more up-to-date information.
