Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information about staff networks.

We received this request on 17 April and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (“the FOI Act”).

Your request and our response

Please include the following information for the financial years 2023/24 and 2024/25:

- 1. A list of all the staff networks at the organisation*

OWN (Ofcom Women’s Network); RACE (Raising Awareness of Culture and Ethnicity); Affinity Network (LGBTQ); PAC (Parents and Carers Network); Sound Network (Disability and Neurodiversity); Social Inclusion Group; Faith Network.

- 2. Whether each network receives internal funding and, if so, how much (please express annually for the last four financial years)*

By way of background, Ofcom is funded by a levy on the industries we regulate rather than by taxes. You can find more information [here](#).

The networks do receive internal funding. Each network is not allocated a specific amount, rather it depends on the specific activities of the particular network. We are therefore able to provide a total networks figure for the requested years.

A network chair can allocate up to 20% of their time to the network.

Please see Annex A for a list of events including date/time, title/subject of the event and which network it was held by for financial year 24/25 and up to the date of your request. We are unable to disclose any personal names as we consider this information is exempt from disclosure under Section 40 of the FOI Act which provides that such information is exempt for the purposes of the Act. Section 40 is an absolute exemption under the Act and does not require a public interest test.

Request an internal review

If you are unhappy with the response you have received to your request for information, or think that your request was refused without a reason valid under the law, you may ask for an internal review. If you do, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will either uphold the original decision, or reverse or modify it.

If you would like to ask us to carry out an internal review, you should get in touch within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for us to complete our internal review, and the time it takes will depend on the complexity of the request. But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress.
