We received this request on 20 August 2025 and we have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your request

Following recent FOI reporting by the FT regarding misconduct related staff dismissals at the Financial Conduct Authority, please supply the following data:

- 1. The number of Ofcom staff dismissed/terminated/sacked for misconduct between 1/1/2022 and 31/12/2024
- 2. The number of Ofcom staff who faced disciplinary proceedings for misconduct between 1/1/2022 and 31/12/2024
- 3. The number of Ofcom staff who received written warnings regarding misconduct between 1/1/2022 and 31/12/2024

Our response

We have provided this information in a <u>previous FOI response</u>. We can confirm that the figures provided in this prior response also apply since 1 January 2022.

Request an internal review

If you do, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom. We will either uphold the original decision, or reverse or modify it.

If you would like to ask us to carry out an internal review, you should get in touch within two months of the date of this letter. There is no statutory deadline for us to complete our internal review, and the time it takes will depend on the complexity of the request. But we will try to complete the review within 20 working days (or no more than 40 working days in exceptional cases) and keep you informed of our progress.
