Please answer the following:

1. Has Ofcom, at any point between 1 January 2025 and 31 January 2025, had any correspondence with Meta Platforms Technologies UK Ltd?

2. If correspondence is confirmed, please indicate at a high level whether it involved:

- legal*
- regulatory/compliance*
- public policy*

(without identifying any individuals)

For each of the above, a simple yes or no confirmation is sufficient, and no further detail is required.

This request is intentionally limited to:

- a single calendar month*
- a small number of clearly defined entities*
- high-level categorisation only*
- binary confirmation as the primary response*

If any part of this request is considered to exceed the cost limit, please respond to whichever of the above questions can be answered within the limit.
