<b>We invite interested parties to provide feedback on the Roadmap.</b>	<p>Confidential? – N</p> <p>We believe there are a significant number of consumers who rely on terrestrial broadcasts to the exclusion of Internet because of their lack of comprehension on the technical aspects of internet television. For some this lack of understanding also inhibits the use of satellite reception, whereas reception of terrestrial television is relatively easy to understand. This lack of understanding presents barriers to alternative means of reception and could result in viewer losing television reception should interference prevent reception.</p> <p>Looking to the future of possible spectrum adjustments the potential for interference from shared band is significant, and as filters could not be used unresolvable. We would recommend that is it not attempted unless it can be proven that adequate protection ratios can be achieved with interfering in band signals. It would be better to retain split band.</p>
